



Grand Canyon National Park - South Rim 2018 ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

IMPORTANT NOTICE for all Visitors

During the 2018 year, there will be ongoing road improvements within Grand Canyon South Rim Village. There will be various detours within the Park and parking will be limited.

We strongly recommend that all visitors traveling north on Hwy. 64 to the Grand Canyon, especially in RV's and larger vehicles, park in the FREE Park & Ride parking lots located in Tusayan (1 mile south of the Park Entrance). You can purchase your park pass at several locations in Tusayan and then take the FREE shuttle to the main visitor center within the Park. From there you can take various shuttles to the spectacular view points along the rim.

Note: If you are lodging within the National Park, please proceed to parking at your hotel or campground.

The FREE shuttle service in Tusayan is seasonal and is only available March through September.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

The National Park Service offers Free Shuttle Bus Service with your Park Pass purchase to assist visitors with our challenging parking. From **March through September** the Park Service has an expanded **Tusayan Purple Route** where you can Park and Ride and speed your way through the entrance station. You can park anywhere in Tusayan and catch the free shuttle at one of the 4 stops conveniently located in town. Be sure to purchase your park pass at one of the multiple business locations in Tusayan prior to boarding the bus. Once inside the park, the National Park Service offers 3 Shuttle Bus Routes (**Village Blue Route**, **Kaibab Rim Orange Route** and **Hermit Road Red Route**.
